Sunday 16th March
Welcome breakfast on Caesarea beach front with keynote speaker
Jeep tour of northern borders , seeing where the UN peacekeepers are stationed, a bunker used during previous wars plus a Geopolitical talk and discussion from former IDF intelligence officer Cpt. (Ret.) Ilan Shulman
Visit the Mas'ade station that was recently renovated by congregants of a Liverpool church , learn more about the Druze story and meet Senior Paramedic Adam Safadi , whose daughter was killed in the Majdal Shams "football field" rocket attack, as well as the MDA heroes that attended the call to save lives amid the chaos
Hear from the Rabbi of the Golani brigade who are currently in Lebanon
Overnight: Kibbutz on the bank of the Galilee
Monday 17th March
Learn about Magen David Adom's different first response vehicles and see the MDA lifeboat on the Kinneret and the northern MDA helicopter
Special visit to Shaare Tzedek Medical Centre to meet with wounded soldiers and/or civilians and hear the Centre's CEO Professor Ofer Merin discuss the challenges of running a hospital during wartime. Prof Merin is also a member of the three physicians committee that is dealing with the medical situation of the hostages.
Visit Mount Herzl and pay your respects to our fallen 7/10 heroes

Overnight: Tel Aviv
Tuesday 18th March
Testimony from MDA EMT Ophir Tor who was shot at by Hamas terrorists on 7/10 on the way to his shift. Once he managed to arrive at the station, they had to turn it into a makeshift Emergency Room. The MDA Sderot station was a top target for the terrorists.
Tour of a Kibbutz affected by 7/10 together with a local resident. Talk on how they are rebuilding their community and looking ahead. Volunteer with some fruit picking to help the local agricultural economy.
Visit the site of the Nova Festival and hear a first-hand testimony from survivor.
See the " Car Wall " in Tkuma where burnt cars have been kept since the tragic events of 7/10, including the burnt MDA ambulance that is kept there.
Hear from Eyal Eshel , father of Roni Eshel, at the destroyed IDF base in Nahal Oz where she was murdered on 7/10.
Go to Hostage Square and meet a family of a hostage and learn about the campaigning of the Hostage Families Forum.
